Koray Caliskan is a tenured Associate Professor of Strategic Design and Management at Parsons and Associate Editor of the Journal of Cultural Economy. His book *Market Threads* came out from Princeton UP and focused on global commodity markets. His research project on cryptocurrencies and their global communities was selected in 2021 to be a [Winner of the Scientific Breakthrough of the Year](#) in Social Sciences and Humanities by the Falling Walls Foundation, Berlin. His book *Data Money: Inside Cryptocurrencies and their Communities, Blockchains and Markets* came out in 2023 from Columbia UP. Currently, on an ESRC grant, he is carrying out research on the economic sociology of online advertisements. He is a founding partner of [The Wrong Department](#), an international strategic design studio with offices in London and New York City. He directed, produced, and wrote many award-winning fiction and documentary films, including *Esma*, shown at Cannes Film Festival. His next book, *Economization: Economies, Markets, and Platforms in Perspective*, co-authored with Michel Callon and Donald MacKenzie, is coming out in 2024 from Columbia UP.
